

### GREY WOLF:

The gray wolf or grey wolf (*Canis lupus*) is a species of canid native to the wilderness and remote areas of North America, Eurasia, and North Africa. It is the largest member of its family. It is similar in general appearance and proportions to a German shepherd, or sled dog, but has a larger head, narrower chest, longer legs, straighter tail and bigger paws. Its winter fur is long and bushy, and predominantly a mottled gray in colour, although nearly pure white, red, or brown to black also occur.

The grey wolf hunts primarily large prey, has a more gregarious nature, and has highly advanced expressive behaviour. It is a social animal, travelling in nuclear families consisting of a mated pair, accompanied by the pair's adult offspring. Humans and tigers are really the only creatures that pose a serious threat to it. It feeds primarily on large ungulates, though it also eats smaller animals, livestock, carrion, and garbage.
